**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Women and Child Development (State and Subordinate) Service Rules, 1998, namely :-

**1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Women and Child Development (State and Subordinate) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.

**2. Amendment of rule 23.-** After the existing first proviso to rule 23 of the Rajasthan Women and Child Development (State and Subordinate) Service Rules, 1998, here in after referred to as the said rules, the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided further that the post of Pre-Primary Education Teacher shall be filled in only by the written examination in accordance with the scheme and syllabus specified in Schedule IV."

**3. Amendment of Schedule II.-** In Schedule-II appended to the said rules, after the existing serial number 7 the following new serial number 8 and entries thereto, shall be added, namely:-

4. **Insertion of new Schedule-IV.-** After the existing Schedule III of the said rules, the following new Schedule IV shall be added, namely:-

**"SCHEDULE IV**

**SCHEME AND SYLLABUS FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE POST OF PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION TEACHER THROUGH WRITTEN EXAMINATION BY THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY (AGAINST 100% OF THE CADRE STRENGTH)**


**Scheme**

- I. **Eligibility.-** A candidate must possess the minimum educational qualification as mentioned in column 5 of Schedule II.
- II. **Examination.-** The examination shall be conducted by the Appointing Authority. The paper will be of objective type (Multiple choice). Paper will be of 100 marks and the minimum passing marks will be 40. Duration of the paper will be 3 hours.

**Syllabus**

- (i) The syllabus and scope of paper for the written examination will be as prescribed by the Appointing Authority from time to time and will be intimated to the candidates within the stipulated time in the manner as the Appointing Authority as deems fit.
- (ii) The standard of paper will be equivalent to two years Nursery Teacher Training Course.
- (iii) The Appointing Authority shall not recommend any candidate who has failed to obtain a minimum of 40% marks."
